Inn Cornwall Uniform Policy

Our uniform policy is important. Being in the right uniform makes you look clean, professional, and part of the team. When you are on shift, you should always be in the correct uniform and prepared to provide guests with a warm welcome.

Front of House Staff

For front of house staff, the uniform should be either a black skirt, trousers or shorts (*not sports shorts*), black shoes, and a branded black polo which will be provided.

If you wear a skirt, it should be a black skirt with tights or black trousers (*not jeans*). Skirts should be of a decent length. Wearing trousers, they should be proper black trousers and not jeans, and you should wear black socks, not white. Please wear comfortable, flat black shoes, if wearing smart trainers then they need to have decent none slip soles.

All staff should wear minimal jewellery, have no nail polish, and their hair tied back. It is important to keep your uniform clean and tidy. No other accessories should be worn.

Pencils should not be stored in your hair while working.

You will be provided with a black apron to wear during service.

Kitchen Staff

For kitchen staff, including chefs and kitchen porters, the uniform policy is as follows:

Chefs

Chefs should wear comfortable shoes, a clean chef jacket with apron, and chef baggies/trousers. It is important to change into your uniform at work and not wear your uniform to work. Safety shoes are important to protect your feet from spills and sharp objects.

Kitchen Porters

Kitchen porters should wear t-shirts, aprons, and baggies. It is important to always keep your uniform clean and tidy.

Uniform Policy - Managers

Managers are expected to maintain a professional appearance while on duty. The uniform for managers includes either a branded polo shirt or a smart shirt, paired with black trousers or a black skirt. Footwear should be black, non-slip shoes that are comfortable for extended periods of wear. It is important to ensure that shoes are both practical and professional.
